



Dandenong District Roads Board

The first local government administration body was the Dandenong District Roads Board which functioned from 1862 to 1873.

The Shire of Dandenong was constituted on 7 May 1873. The members of the Dandenong District Roads Board automatically became the members of the first Council.

Both Springvale and Dandenong were governed by the Dandenong District Roads Board and then the Shire of Dandenong until 1955, when Springvale and Noble Park split from the Shire of Dandenong to form the Shire of Springvale and Noble Park.
