Cranbourne Cemetery has so many stories to tell. Join us on a ninety minute walk around this historic cemetery and explore some of its history as we tell you the stories of twenty-six people and their families who had no chance to say goodbye.

They came from Poowong, Skye, Lyndhurst, Koo Wee Rup, Clyde and Cranbourne. Hear stories of a father who died alone on the side of a road and thirteen years later his son died alone at the foot of a tree. Meet the policeman and a policeman's wife, a man murdered for his boots and the unknown man.
